Mr. Csaba Borboly expressed his opinion in favour of the rural areas of the European Union

At the Plenary Session of the Committee of the Regions Mr. Csaba Borboly submitted modifying proposals regarding the greater financial collaborations of the European Union as well as regarding financial supports for using renewable energies. The president of Harghita County Council since October of 2012 is a member in the Committee of the Regions.

On 31st of January and 1st of February 2013 in Brussels one of the most important advisory bodies of the European Union, the Committee of the Regions held a meeting for discussing topics like: 'Creating greater synergies between EU, national and subnational budgets', as well as 'Renewable Energy: A major player in the European energy market'. With regard to these topics Mr. Csaba Borboly, president of Harghita County Council submitted

Closer to the EU decision-making processes Harghita County Council was elected as member of the SMN

On 5th February the Committee of the Region accepted the application of Harghita County Council regarding the Subsidiarity Monitoring Network – SMN.

The Subsidiarity Monitoring Network (SMN) was launched in April 2007, and its aim is to facilitate the exchange of information between local and regional authorities in the European Union regarding various documents, legislative and political proposals from the European Commission.

The decisions are debated by the members of the SMN through consultations and various activities for validating the interests on the level of the European Union. The network is thus intended to act as an access point enabling all of its partners not only to obtain information but also to express their views within the EU legislative processes but also ahead of this process. On behalf of Harghita County Council from Romania, Mr. President Csaba Borboly proposed the common project toward improving the life circumstances and well-

A delegation of Hungarian Olympic Committee visited Harghita County. The members of this delegation were interested in the plan of Harghita County Council to establish a mountain sport complex based on the entrepreneur's, namely Mr. Róbert Ilyés' idea. The mountain sport complex will be built on 1700 meter above the sea level, on

a territory covering 20-25 ha, where the view is gorgeous and the meteorological conditions are not grim and unpredictable, like these are at alpine height (mountains over 2000 meters height).

This complex could be a preparatory camp too for athletes in any sport, because – after the specialists' opinion – this height and climate is ideal for trainings. Read more....
