Starting from 19th of October on the webpage www.szekelytermek.ro a list concerning the enterprises participating in the Traditional and Local product Fair in Miercurea Ciuc (Csíkszereda) is available. The abovementioned website also provides a list of products of local producers and enterprises. The fair organized in every third Saturday of each month by Harghita County Council in collaboration with the Agricultural Chamber of Harghita County takes place at the administrative building of the



county council. Harghita County Council by organizing the monthly fairs aims to provide support and help for the local producers in selling their goods and products. At the same time, these fairs offer the possibility for the locals to regularly purchase healthy local products. Mr. Eduárd Károly Novák from Miercurea Ciuc (Csíkszereda), ciclist brought back a Gold medal, reaching at the same time a new world record in London on 1_{st} of September 2012. The athlete realizing a great result won the 4 km long competition in C4 category, on Saturday afternoon, outran the Czech Juri Jezek, who won the silver medal, and the British Jody Cundy, who won the bronze medal. Novák has reached the new record of 4:40.315 in the preselection category.
