Owing to the successful organization of the Sekler Product Agricultural Cooperative, on 25th of November the Sekler Products' shop was opened. The cooperative was established in 2013 and its members are 16 associations and companies, as well as 5



individual entrepreneurs. During the opening ceremony, the president of the cooperative, Mr. István Márton, director of the Rural Development Association of Harghita County Council welcomed the participants. He said that after overcoming several difficulties they could realize the launch of this shop, in order to offer the possibility for local producers to their local and traditional products. The Progress project "Young Graduates and the Social Sector: Developing new job opportunities" is close to end in Harghita county


